Our October Meeting will be a joint meeting with the ASME Mid-Continent Section. We will be enjoying a tour of AEP PSO Riverside Power Station. Please join us!

The plant can generate just over 900 MW using its two conventional gas-fired steam turbine generators. AEP PSO completed 170 MW of new simple-cycle, natural gas-fueled generation at the Riverside plant in 2008. With the addition of the two new gas combustion turbines, the plant's peak capacity has increased to nearly 1,100 MW. The tour will concentrate on the new combustion turbines.
